

Uniform Requirements

The emphasis is neatness and pride in our uniform, both to reflect our attitude to the school and ourselves.

Please note: School rules apply anywhere a pupil is identifiable as a member of the Hyde Park High School community. It is obviously particularly important that the uniform be worn properly in public places such as on buses and in shopping centres, and on the way to and from school.

The **school uniform** includes and is not limited to:

<p>Boys</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Grey pants, which have not been tapered with a plain grey or black belt. <input type="checkbox"/> Grey socks with plain leather black lace-up, round-toed shoes. <input type="checkbox"/> A sleeveless navy jersey (white for matrices) with the school badge on it. <input type="checkbox"/> A long-sleeved navy V-necked jersey (white for matrices) may be worn but only with a blazer. <input type="checkbox"/> The blazer must be worn daily in Terms 2 & 3 and is optional in Terms 1 & 4. <input type="checkbox"/> Jewellery of a religious type may be worn but must not be visible. <input type="checkbox"/> <u>For Physical Education</u> – blue Hyde Park shorts and a white golf shirt with the school badge. Black swimming costume or team costume can also be used. Sports coaches will advise on kits for specific sports. 	
<p><u>Summer:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> A white golf shirt with the school badge on it which need not be tucked in. Oversized shirts are not acceptable. <input type="checkbox"/> No items of clothing may be worn under the shirt such as T-shirts or vests that are wildly coloured or with logos on them. <input type="checkbox"/> A plain navy raincoat may be worn if it is raining. 	<p><u>Winter:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> A white shirt with the school tie. Golf shirts are not permitted in Terms 2 & 3. <input type="checkbox"/> The school navy scarf with the school colours or a plain navy scarf. A white scarf may only be worn by members of first teams. <input type="checkbox"/> The school tracksuit top may be worn under the blazer when it is very cold but it cannot be worn without a shirt and tie underneath it.
<p>Girls</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> A pleated grey skirt as supplied by the school stockists, which is four fingers above the knee OR grey pants, which have not been tapered. <input type="checkbox"/> Plain leather black lace-up, round-toed shoes. <input type="checkbox"/> A sleeveless navy jersey (white for matrices) with the school badge on it. <input type="checkbox"/> A long-sleeved navy V-necked jersey (white for matrices) may be worn but only with a blazer. <input type="checkbox"/> The blazer must be worn daily in Terms 2 & 3 and is optional in Terms 1 & 4. <input type="checkbox"/> No make-up or coloured nail varnish may be worn by the girls and finger nails must be kept short. 	

- No jewellery or other adornments except a watch, plain gold or silver stud earrings or a medic alert bracelet may be worn whilst in school uniform or in sport uniform.
- Jewellery of a religious type may be worn but must not be visible.
- Hair accessories must be brown, black, tortoiseshell, white, navy, red or yellow and only one colour at a time.
- For Physical Education – blue Hyde Park shorts and a white golf shirt with the school badge. Black swimming costume or team costume can also be used. Sports coaches will advise on kits for specific sports.

Summer:

- A white open-necked shirt with the school badge on the pocket, rounded at the bottom and not tucked in.
- White socks with the pleated grey school skirt OR grey socks with the grey pants.
- No items of clothing may be worn under the shirt such as T-shirts or vests that are wildly coloured or with logos on them.
- A sleeveless navy jersey (white for matrices) with the school badge on it.
- A long-sleeved navy V-necked jersey may be worn but only with a blazer.
- A plain navy raincoat may be worn if it is raining.

Winter:

- A white shirt with the school tie.
- Black or grey stockings or long grey socks with the pleated grey school skirt OR grey socks with the grey pants.
- The school navy scarf with the school colours or a plain navy scarf. A white scarf may only be worn by members of first teams.
- The school tracksuit top may be worn under the blazer when it is very cold but it cannot be worn without a shirt and tie underneath it.

The **hair rules** are as follows:

Boys

- They must look neat.
- They must be clean-shaven.
- The hair when pulled down must not touch the eyebrows, ears, or shirt-collar.
- The hair must follow the shape of the head (i.e. no gel, spikes, or 'afros').
- Sideburns may not be below the centre of the ear.
- The colour of the hair must not draw attention to itself.

Girls

- They must look neat.
- If the hair is longer than the collar, it must be tied up.
- Hair may not fall into the face.
- The colour of the hair must not draw attention to itself.

Hats, caps and beanies

These are not part of the school uniform. School caps may only be worn in the sun and after school.

Tracksuits

Regulation Hyde Park High School tracksuits are the only tracksuits to wear to and from games and after practice, with appropriate sports shoes. Pupils who represent Hyde Park should wear the school tracksuit as part of their team outfit.

School Bags

Textbooks are expensive and it is important that these are looked after properly. Suitable sturdy navy blue school bags are recommended.
