Cycle test procedure – Term 3

Parents are reminded that there are cycle exams next term and the cycle timetable will be issued within the first 10 days. Please familiarise yourself with your child's exam schedule.

NOTE :

In the event that your child is absent from school for a cycle exam, a doctor's certificate is required which needs to be handed in to your child's Grade Head on the day of his/her return, before the first period starts. Be aware that your child may still not be able to write the exam, since it may be compromised. **In addition it is mandatory that a phone call to the office is made on the day that your child is absent before 08h30.** Ideally we would ask that your child comes in to write the exam on the day, even though they may not be well, and that you provide a letter for him/her to leave immediately thereafter. The school will close at 14h20 on Mondays and Fridays due to cycle exams.

Prelims

The matric pupils are encouraged to focus on their studies with their prelims beginning on 28th August 2017. The effort put into these exams will pay off when the final exams take place!

Dress and Hair Regulation

We ask all parents to encourage their children to wear the Hyde Park High uniform with pride and follow the correct dress and hair code. Use this holiday time to be prepared for the new term. All pupils are to wear the correct sports uniform for practices as well as matches. Measles Vaccinations! (not so ouch)

The Grade 8 and 9 pupils at Hyde Park High had the opportunity to be vaccinated during the national Measles Vaccination Campaign which took place from 15 May to 30 June 2017 for pupils from the age of 6 months to 15 years. The Department of Health required a document to be signed by their parents giving permission for this vital inoculation for Measles, a disease which can be easily spread, causing symptoms such as high fever, coughing, runny nose and a rash. Some children were apprehensive and unsure of what to expect, but were pleasantly surprised at how little they felt when receiving their injections. The nurses from the Randburg Department of Health were very efficient in processing all 270 pupils within a very short period of time and almost no academic time was lost during this process.
