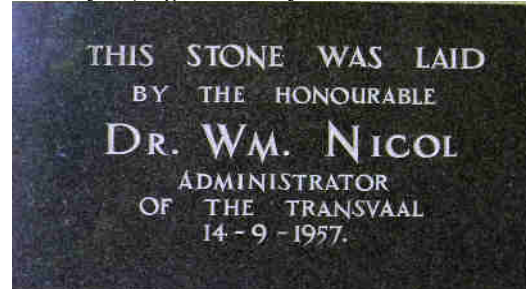

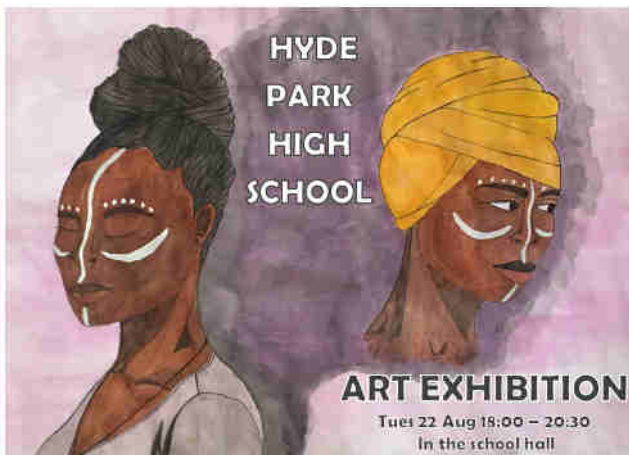

Hyde Park High was proud to be placed 6th out of 22 schools in the School League for the 2017 season. Well done to all our swimmers for their participation and effort.

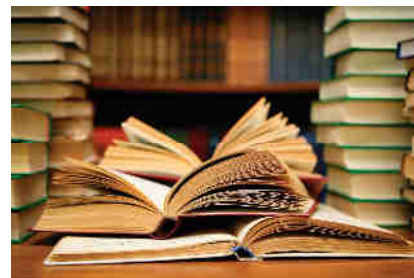
Soccer News
